Student Veteran Services provides supportive services necessary to ensure that student veterans are successful in their academic pursuits, adjust to the campus environment, and eventually transition to civilian employment.

**Mr. Rick Poe, Veteran's Affairs VetSuccess Counselor** – Rick is a veteran, and serves as the VetSuccess Counselor. It is his responsibility to provide counseling services to veterans on campus. He connects them with resources they may need to adjust to the college atmosphere. East Carolina University is the only university in the State that has this program.
