Staff Senate Minutes

Wednesday, March 10, 2015

Call to Order:

Meeting was called to order at 3:04 p.m. by Chair Mary Schiller

Guest Speaker:

Dr. Paul Lindauer, DSS, School of Dental Medicine, said the Dental School trains tomorrow's leaders in dental medicine of the future. Dr. Lindauer spoke very highly of the student body, "they are dedicated and hungry for knowledge; these students are at the top of the class in dental medicine". Community service learning centers are branching out across the state to address the shortage of dentists in rural and underserved areas, currently serving seven locations including: Ahoskie, Elizabeth City, Lillington, Spruce Pine, Sylva, Robeson County and Greenville. ECU School of Dental Medicine only accepts North Carolina residents and expects the dentist to serve and practice within the state of NC; therefore, North Carolina tax payers get a big bang for their buck. Dr. Paul Lindauer thanked the Senators for all that the Staff Senate does and recognized that the staff makes things happen across campus and appreciates the staff and said "hats off to you". Dr. Paul Lindauer shared pictures of the Ross Hall and the dental facility; he said the facility sells itself. Dr. Paul Lindauer said the clinics provide great care; however, patients can expect a wait because of the teaching environment. Dental x-rays are captured on a modern digital imaging system on the cutting edge of technology. Parents of dental students are very impressed on family day and very proud. All of the medical labs are wired to service the learning centers across the state. The research facility is in future plans, maybe within five years. The first graduation ceremony will be held on May 8, 2015, the graduating class and the faculty are very proud of this achievement. Senator Kim Higdon asked how many dental students; Dr. Paul Lindauer answered there are 204 students currently enrolled, with a 52 student limit per class.

Roll Call:

Senator Penney Doughtie, Secretary, called the roll and a quorum was present (see attached attendance sheet).

Approval of Minutes:

February minutes are not complete.

Chair Mary Schiller:

Chair Mary Schiller attended the ECU Board of Trustees meeting on February 20, 2015. During this session the BOT members voted to transition the Aycock Residence Hall to Heritage Hall, currently under construction. This will be a permanent place where people of historic significance to the university are honored in an "authentic and comprehensive context." Also, a new curriculum will be created for ECU students to be educated about the history of ECU. BOT members sworn in the new ECU SGA President, Jake Srednicki, he will complete the 2014/15 term. The ECU Board of Trustees appointed Dr. Ron Mitchelson as the new Provost. This is good news for the Staff Senate, because Dr. Mitchelson is a major advocate for the Staff Senate. Also, during the February meeting, the BOT received information regarding the Title IX policy and sexual assault awareness. The BOT voted to create a Millennial Campus to be named the East Carolina Research and Innovation Campus. The BOT approved the purchase of the former ABC store on Cotanche Street and approved the lease of off-campus apartments.

Vice Chancellor, Senators, and Executive Council meetings have been scheduled and calendar invitations have been sent. The meetings with Dr. Virginia Hardy and Dr. Ron Mitchelson were very positive.

Chair Mary Schiller reported that the Staff Senate received many questions and complaints regarding the February adverse weather events. These issues have been discussed with ECU Human Resources. The State of North Carolina has recently updated the policy for state agencies. The new policy is located at

Many of the issues experienced were due to the timing of the release of the new policy in correlation to the adverse weather. ECU is in process of updating the ECU Policies and has committed to presenting the policies to the Staff Senate once complete. Chair Mary Schiller would like to hold discussions until the policies are completed and meaningful conversations and input can be given. HR Director Melissa Bard apologized for the untimely announcements via text/email and multiple follow up communications. Senator Teresa Tripp stated the revised Adverse weather policy now allows 90 days to make up adverse weather time compared to the old policy of 12 months. Senator LuAnn Sullivan said that some supervisors do not want employees to make up time. HR Director Melissa Bard agreed; however, supervisors should be flexible. She stated that employees can make up time that would give employee overtime with the approval of the supervisor.

Chair Schiller announced the Chancellor's Cup Golf Tournament on Tuesday, April 7th. Volunteers are needed and senators were asked to sign up. Also, sponsors are needed, every sponsor will give 15% to ECU's scholarships. More information is available on the following website http://uncchancellorscup.com/sponsors.html.

The Staff Senate Office relocated from the Old Cafeteria building to storage space in Austin. Chair Mary Schiller asked that office keys for the Old Cafeteria building office be returned to her.

Chair-Elect Lisa Ormond Comments:

Chair-Elect Lisa Ormond, Senator LuAnn Sullivan, Senator Kim Higdon, and Ex Officio Garrett Killian attended the UNC Staff Assembly on February 23rd and 24th. Chair-Elect Lisa Ormond attended a session titled "Transforming Staff & Faculty Relationships", which encouraged working relationships between faculty and staff. Each senate was recommended to complete a climate survey. New Vice President of UNC GA, Mathew Brody, was introduced and supports the Staff Senate. UNC Partnership for National Security was another topic discussed during the assembly. This organization is a system-wide effort to support service members, and is committed to increase military enrollment and to help veterans transition from military life to student life. ECU was recognized as a model in this effort because ECU is the leader in the state for military enrollment. Chair-Elect Lisa Ormond encouraged the senators to attend the Vice Chancellor meetings for their designated division and bring questions. The Janet B.
