#### **Speaker**

#### STEPHANIE SUMNER, ARAMARK DISTRICT MARKETING MANAGER

Campus dining launched its newest website a year ago: <u>www.ecu.edu/dining</u> This website includes: 26 dining locations on campus, hours of operation, contact numbers, menus, and calorie counters. Aramark has also tied all menus into the phone app, My Fitness Pal.

Catering: This part of the website would be most helpful for staff. This is where all catering orders are entered and it includes all catering menus.

Social Media: they get a lot of feedback from social media. There are also coupons available. Everyone at ECU is encouraged to follow Aramark on campus. New faculty/staff meal plan: "Season Pass" will provide an ECU employee with 20

meals on campus for \$100 a semester at Todd or West End dining hall at any time, including premium night meals (breaks down to \$5 per meal). On West Campus the meal plan can be used at The Wedge as well. In order to obtain access to this plan, contact ECU Dining Services and they will add it to the employee OneCard. Next week: Starbucks Mobile Truck is coming to campus, similar to a food truck. The truck will mainly park in the parking lot behind Christenbury gym, at home football games and eventually the medical campus. There are only 3 trucks in the entire country and one will be here at ECU. Senator Heather Seibert-Racine asked if the truck will be available year round or just during class times. Stephanie Sumner said this might be the alternative to keeping a Starbucks running on campus during slower, non-class events.

Keisha Brown (HR) mentioned that it would be nice to have the truck visit outlying areas of campus, such as the HR Building that doesn't have vending centrally located.

#### **Executive Committee Comments - Senator Lisa Ormond**

**STATE BUDGET:** Since the budget hasn't officially passed there is not any new information to share. The possible bonus included in the new budget is a one-time \$750 bonus for all employees.

**LEADERSHIP & PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT AD-HOC COMMITTEE**: This committee has been charged in past with promoting activities for professional development for the Senate. There are now 10 minute leadership videos that Staff Senate as a group will watch during the new business segment of the meeting. Senator Patrick Everett was invited to tell us a quick description of the videos. Course topics include effective listening, influencing change. Senators are asked to let the committee know if they have any topic suggestions in the future. This series will start in October.

# **Old Business**

# **REVIEW OF HR SURVEY:**

In an earlier Staff Senate meeting there was a survey of the top 3 areas of HR concern:

**Adverse weather policy**: The State policy is the policy ECU is acting under. **Career banding classification system**: This issue and the SPA performance policy will be charged to the HR committee in this fiscal year.

**Flexible Scheduling:** This is approved at the campus and it is encouraged. However, it doesn't filter down to all departments. There are some that are flexible and some that aren't. The Executive Committee talked with Melissa Bard about ways to encourage flex scheduling and it is going to take a while before we can get everyone on the same page.

The goal of Executive Committee is to focus on a couple of items each meeting and take it to the Human Resources Committee or Human Resources Department at ECU. Senator Patricia Simpson asked if it is possible to get flex scheduling on the University Executive Council agenda. Chair Lisa Ormond responded that the Staff Senate Executive Council is meeting with the Chancellor's Executive Council in October.

It seems that one of the largest issues in the University is with the use of Kronos. There are many misconceptions and misunderstandings on using Kronos. Some senators spoke favorably on using Kronos and other Senators spoke negatively. As the use of Kronos grows in the University by department then the kinks and learning curve associated with it will hopefully get worked out.
